The Weight of the World

Find the 43 bold words from Mark 10:17-22 (PP).

And as **Jesus** was setting out on his **journey**, a man **ran** up and **kneled** before him and asked him, “**Good Teacher**, what do I have to do to **inherit eternal life**?” So **Jesus** answered him, “Why do you call me good? **God alone** is good; no one else is good. You **know** the **commandments**: ‘Do not **murder**. Do not **commit adultery**. Do not **steal**. Do not **bear false witness**. Do not **defraud**. **Honor** your **father** and **mother**.’” He answered **Jesus**, “Teacher, I have **kept** all of these commandments since I was a **boy**.” Then **Jesus**, **looking** at him, **loved** him, and said to him, “You do **lack** this one thing: Go and **sell** all that you have and **give** to the **poor**; and you will have **treasure in heaven**; and **come**, **follow** me.” **Discouraged** by the **saying**, the man went away with a **heavy heart** because he was **weighed** down by his many **possessions**.
