## A Wise Guy

*Find the 33 bold words from Mark 12:28-34 (PP).*

One of the **scribes** came near and heard the **Sadducees** **disputing** with **Jesus** and seeing that he **asked** them a great **question**, “Which **commandment** is the most **important**?” Jesus **answered**, “The **greatest** is, ‘**Hear**, O Israel: the **Lord** our **God**, the Lord is **one**; you shall **love** the Lord your God with all your **heart**, and with all your **soul**, and with all your **mind**, and with all your **strength**.’ The second is this, ‘You shall love your **neighbor** as **yourself**.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.” Then the scribe said to him, “You are **correct**, **Teacher**; you have **rightly** said that he is one, and besides him there is no other, and to love him with all your heart, **understanding**, and strength, and to love one’s neighbor as **oneself**—these are far more important than **burnt offerings** and **sacrifices**.” When Jesus saw that he answered **wisely**, he said to him, “You are not far from the **kingdom** of God.” After that no one **dared** to ask him any question.
