## Engulfed in Glory

*Find the 39 bold words from Luke 9:28-36 (PP).*

Eight days after instructing his disciples about his **death**, Jesus took **Peter** and **John** and **James** up a **mountain** to **pray**. As he prayed, the **appearance** of his face was changed and his **clothing glistened white**. Suddenly two men, **Moses** and **Elijah**, appeared in **glory** and were **talking** with him about his **departure** that he would accomplish at **Jerusalem**. Peter and those with him were very **sleepy** but when they **awoke**, they saw his glory, and the two men that **stood** with him. As they were **departing** from Jesus, Peter said to him, “**Master**, it is **good** for us to be here; now let us make **three tents**—one for you, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah.” Peter did not know what he was saying. While he spoke, a **cloud overshadowed** them and they were **afraid** as it **engulfed** them. And from out of the cloud a voice said, “This is my **beloved Son**; **listen** to him.” When the **voice** passed, Jesus was **alone**.
