Would you like to prepare a breakfast casserole to share Easter morning? You could bring it by the Providence fellowship hall on your way to the cemetery. They'll keep it warm in their ovens. Let me know if you will so I can tell them how many casseroles we will have coming. Here is a recipe to get you started:

Ingredients: 1 lb breakfast sausage; 3 c shredded potatoes, drained and pressed; ¼ cup melted butter; 12 oz mild Cheddar cheese; ½ c shredded onion; 16 oz of either small curd cottage cheese or cream cheese; 6 jumbo eggs.

Directions: Preheat oven to 375°; lightly grease 9x13 baking dish; brown, drain, and crumble sausage; stir together shredded potatoes and butter and line bottom and sides of the baking dish with mixture; mix sausage, cheeses, onion, and eggs; pour over the potato mixture. Bake 1 hour in the preheated oven, or until toothpick inserted into center of the casserole comes out clean.

The Insistent Mob

Find the 33 bold words from Luke 23:13-25 (PP).

Pilate gathered the **chief priests, leaders,** and the **people** and said to them, “You brought me this **man** as one who was **perverting** the people and I have **examined** him here in your presence and have not found this man **guilty** of any of your **charges**. Nor has **Herod**, who sent him back to us. Indeed, he has done nothing to **deserve death**. So I will have him **flogged** and **release** him.” Then they all **shouted** out, “Away with him! **Release** Barabbas for us!” **Barabbas** was a man who had been put in **prison** for an **insurrection** in the city, and for **murder**.) Pilate, wanting to release **Jesus**, addressed them again; but they kept shouting, “**Crucify** him!” He said to them a **third time**, “Why, what **evil** has he done? I have found in him no **ground** for the death **sentence**; so I will have him flogged and then release him.” But they **insisted** with loud shouts that he should be crucified; and their voices **prevailed**. So Pilate gave his **verdict** that their **demand** should be granted. He released the man they asked for, the one who had been put in prison for insurrection and murder, and he **handed** Jesus over as they **wished**.
