Some Helpful Quotations

by Martin Luther

There is not a word in the Bible which is *extra cruem*, which can be understood without reference to the cross.

This life therefore is not righteousness, but growth in righteousness, not health, but healing, not being but becoming, not rest but exercise. We are not yet what we shall be, but we are growing toward it, the process is not yet finished, but it is going on, this is not the end, but it is the road. All does not yet gleam in glory, but all is being purified.

The Bible is the cradle wherein Christ is laid and the swaddling clothes in which Christ is wrapped.

Either sin is with you, lying on your shoulders, or it is lying on Christ, the Lamb of God. Now if it is lying on your back, you are lost; but if it is resting on Christ, you are free, and you will be saved. Now choose what you want.

Anthing that one imagines of God apart from Christ is only useless thinking and vain idolatry.

Lord Jesus, you are my righteousness, I am your sin. You have taken upon yourself what is mine and given me what is yours. You have become what you were not so that I might become what I was not.

Such Faith as This

Find the 34 bold words from Luke 7:3-7, 9-10 (ESV).

When the **centurion** heard about **Jesus**, he **sent** to him **elders** of the **Jews**, **asking** him to **come** and **heal** his **servant**. And when they came to Jesus, they **pleaded** with him **earnestly**, saying, “He is **worthy** to have you do this for him, for he **loves** our **nation**, and he is the one who **built** us our **synagogue**.” And Jesus went with them. When he was not **far** from the **house**, the centurion sent **friends**, saying to him, “**Lord**, do not **trouble** yourself, for I am not worthy to have you come under my **roof**. Therefore I did not **pre-sume** to come to you. But say the **word**, and let my servant be healed. When Jesus heard these things, he **marveled** at him, and **turning** to the **crowd** that **followed** him, said, “I tell you, not even in **Israel** have I found such **faith**.” And when those who had been sent **returned** to the house, they **found** the servant **well**.
