Which of them therefore will **love** him most?” **Simon** answered, “I suppose him whom he forgave the most **money**.” And he replied, “You have **judged correctly**.” And turning to the **woman**, he said to Simon, “Do you see this woman? I entered into your **house** and you gave me no **water** for my **feet**. But she has **bathed** my feet with her **tears** and **dried** them with her **hair**. You gave me no **kiss** but she, since the time I came in, has not stopped kissing my feet. You did not **anoint** my **head** with **oil** but she has anointed my feet with **ointment**.
