The Kingdom on Feet

Find the 37 bold words from Luke 10:2-9 (UV).

Jesus said to them, “The **harvest** is **plenteous** indeed, but the **laborers** are **few**. **Pray** therefore to the **Lord** of the harvest that he **send laborers** into his harvest. Go your ways and **beware**; I send you out as **lambs** in the **midst** of **wolves**. **Carry** no **purse**, no **wallet**, no **shoes**; and **greet** no **man** on the way. And into whatever **house** you shall **enter**, first say, ‘**Peace** be to this house.’ And if a **son** of peace be there, your peace shall **rest** upon him; but if not, it shall **return** to you. And **remain** in that same house, **eating** and **drinking** such things as they **give**, for the laborer is **worthy** of his **pay**. Do not go from house to house. And into whatever **city** you **enter** that receives you, eat such things as are set before you, and **heal** the **sick** that are there, and say to them, ‘The **kingdom** of **God** has come **near** to you.’”
