*Find the 43 bold words from Luke 14:25-33 (UV).*

Large crowds followed Jesus now. He turned and said to them, “If you come to me but do not **hate** your own **father** and **mother** and **wife** and **children** and **brothers** and **sisters**, and yes, even your own **life** too, you cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not **carry** his **own** **cross** and **follow** me cannot be my disciple. For which of you, **desiring** to **build** a **tower**, does not **first sit down** and **consider** the **cost** to **determine** if he has the **funds** to **complete** it? For if he has laid a **foundation** and is not **able** to **finish**, all who were **watching** will begin to **mock** him, saying, ‘This man began to build but was not able to finish.’ Or what **king**, as he goes to **encounter** another king in **war**, will not sit down first and take **counsel** whether he is able with ten thousand to **meet** him who comes against him with twenty thousand? Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sends an **ambassador** to **ask conditions** of **peace**. So then, whoever of you who does **re-nounce** all that he has cannot be my **disciple**.”
